**Purpose:** Provide an overview of filtering inappropriate material from the Internet.

Craven Community College has determined that certain content should be filtered from the College network. This content includes peer-to-peer and pornographic content as outlined in 020109, Monitoring System Access and Use.

The College also employs the blocking of malicious websites through the use of Trend Micro OfficeScan antivirus suite.

These measures are to comply with the following state requirements:

- Employees should not accidentally or deliberately view, access or download inappropriate materials from the Internet that may cause concern or distress to themselves or other employees.
- Employees are restricted from inappropriate use that may result in criminal or civil penalties to the College or state.
- Corrective actions can be taken for instances of inappropriate use.
