Referral Forms

Each semester students must have

1. a completed referral from an instructor in-hand on his/her first visit to each of the ASC labs or
2. a completed referral sent by the instructor to the ASC before we can provide ASC services to a student.

The ASC will be in a position to provide services to a student only when the necessary referral accompanies the student when he/she visits the ASC or when we are in receipt of an instructor generated referral that you have e-mailed to us. Therefore, your students must request a referral from you in class, through e-mail or by phone.

Services

The Academic Skills Center (ASC) provides academic support to curriculum students who are enrolled in courses at all levels. The ASC staff provides free tutorial services through the Math Lab, Writing Lab, and Computer Lab. In addition, the ASC offers peer tutoring, online tutoring, and a variety of helpful workshops.

The ASC also works with students who have learning and physical disabilities. Students with disabilities who wish to request academic accommodations should contact the Director of the Academic Skills Center.

There are ASC locations at both the new Bern and Havelock campuses. Both new Bern and Havelock administer distance education and make-up tests.

Math Lab



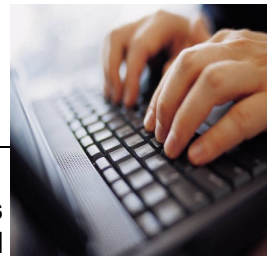
The Math Lab is an open lab available to students taking math courses at all levels. Math tutors may not always be available for one-on-one tutoring. However, students who have visited the math lab and wish to work with a tutor one-on-one should contact the Director or Manager of the ASC.

Writing Lab

The Writing Lab is an open lab available to all curriculum students seeking help with writing and research skills. Tutors may not always be available for one-on-one tutoring. However, students who have visited the writing lab and wish to work with a tutor one-on-one should contact the Director or Manager of the ASC.
