

What is TRiO Student Support Services?

A program established by Congress to help disadvantaged students to enter college, graduate and move on to participate more fully in America's economic and social life. These programs are funded under the Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and are known as TRiO Programs. These programs generally provide information, counseling, academic instruction, tutoring, assistance in applying for financial aid, encouragement and support.

Craven Community College's Student Support Services program is designed to serve 180 students whose parents have not completed a four-year degree, whose family income may hinder them from remaining in college, and/or those students with a documented disability.
