



## What can be recycled in my blue bin?

The Green Team would like to **THANK YOU** for your help in making the campus wide recycling program a success. The Craven Community College Recycling program is a co-mingled system, meaning that **ALL** of your recyclables can go into the **SAME BIN!** This makes recycling at CCC easy for all of us!

### Paper

- Office paper
- Note:
  - ALL colors can be recycled.
  - Remove staples and paper clips
  - Glossy magazines cannot be recycled

### Plastic

- Soft drink bottles
- Water bottles
- Any other plastic with a #1 or #2 (the number can be found inside the recycling symbol on the bottom of the container)
- Note:
  - ALL colors can be recycled.
  - Please remove the lid and empty the container before placing an item in the bin.

### Glass

- Clear, brown and green glass
- Note:
  - Please remove the lids and empty the container before placing it in the bin

### Aluminum

- Soft drink cans
- Note:
  - Please empty the can before placing it in the bin.

### Steel

- Food cans only (e.g. soup cans)
- Note:
  - Please rinse the can to remove food debris before placing it in the bin.

### Cardboard

- Corrugated (thick, heavy shipping boxes)
- Paperboard (e.g. frozen dinner, cereal, soda, yogurt boxes)
- Note:
  - Please flatten corrugated boxes and place them next to your bin.
  - Please flatten paperboard and place it in your blue bin.

*No one can do everything, but everyone can do something!*
