TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PROHIBITION

All students, employees and visitors to Craven Community College are subject to the College’s tobacco and unregulated nicotine policy, procedures, and regulations.

College tobacco and nicotine procedures are intended to provide students, employees and the public with a safe and healthful campus environment. The use of tobacco, nicotine delivery products, and electronic nicotine delivery systems ("ENDS") on the property or premises of the College’s campuses is determined to be detrimental to the health and safety of students, employees and visitors.

Accordingly, the use of tobacco, nicotine delivery products and ENDS is prohibited in all campus buildings, facilities and vehicles owned or leased by the College. The prohibition of these designated products extends to all property or grounds of the New Bern and the Havelock-Cherry Point Campus except for specifically designated official smoking areas.

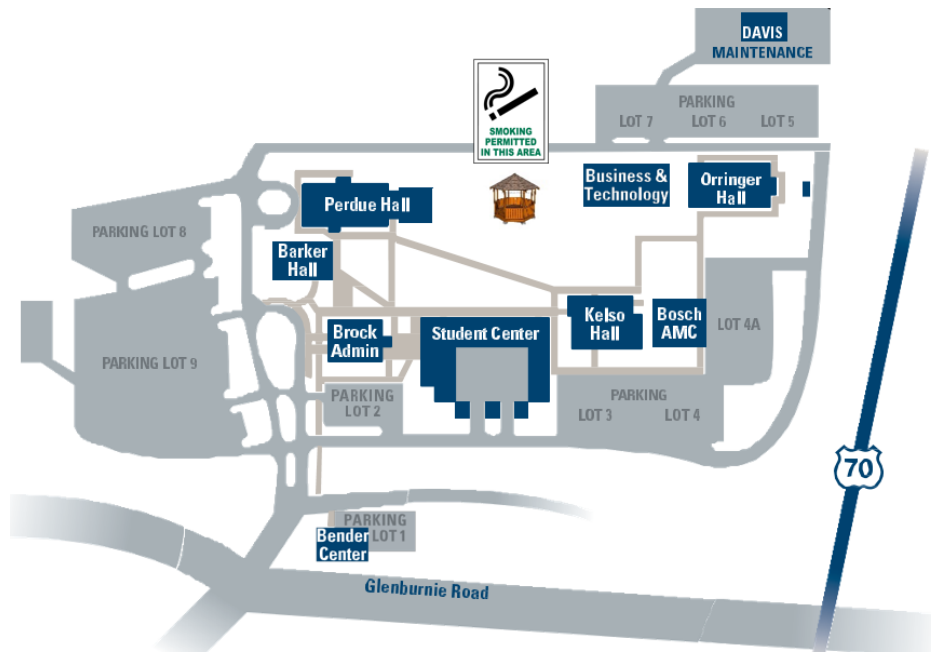
Infractions

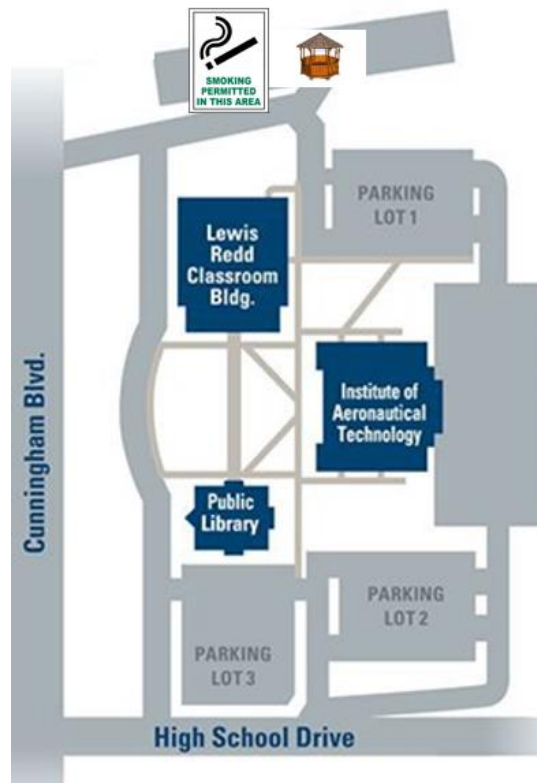
Designated Smoking Areas

Smoking, the use of nicotine delivery products or ENDS, is permitted on campus grounds only in specific, designated official smoking areas. All students, employees, and visitors shall adhere to this procedure and restrict their use of tobacco, nicotine delivery products, and ENDS to such designated areas while on campus. Both the New Bern and Havelock campuses have official designated smoking areas as follows:
