Officer Requirements

1. Be in good academic standing, 2.8 cumulative GPA or better
2. Be a curriculum student and enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per fall and spring semesters
3. Freshmen are eligible to run apart from not having a grade point average
4. Have tested out or have already completed all remedial/developmental coursework.
5. Must serve a term of one academic year from July to June.

Restrictions

SGA officers cannot be an officer in any other club or organization with the exception of Phi Theta Kappa National Honor Society.
