Role of the Student Government Association:

- The Student Government Association is a representative organization for the Craven Community College student body. The SGA provides students a forum for open discussion and serves as an advocate for the students by presenting issues and concerns to the administration.
- Responsible for conducting surveys to find out the interests and issues of the entire student body
- Voices the opinions of all students

Senator Requirements:

1. Be in good academic standing, 2.5 cumulative GPA or better.
2. Be a curriculum student and enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
3. Freshmen are eligible to apply apart from not having a college GPA
4. Have tested out or have already completed all remedial/developmental coursework
5. Must serve a term of one academic year from September through April

The Senator's Role:

- a. Represent their academic area and be the voice for that group
- b. Serve on SGA judicial review boards when requested
- c. Attend meetings and activities as scheduled
- d. Assist in publicizing student and events

SGA Executive Board and Senator Contrast:

While the SGA Executive Board and Senator have similar rights and obligations, there are some distinct differences between these two vitally important roles within the SGA.

- While Executive Board positions are obligated to one designated task, Senators have more liberty as to what tasks are designated to them
- Senators are not required to fulfill the 5 hour per week demand that is set for Executive Board members.
- Senators do not receive academic tuition assistance
