Program options range from certificates and diplomas to two-year Associate of Applied Science degrees. Career Programs allow students to start at the certificate level for most programs and build to a one-year diploma and, ultimately, an associate degree. Course offering and delivery methods include seated, hybrid (seated/online), and online; many courses are offered both day and night and some are offered on Saturdays.

Our coursework develops your ability to communicate professionally and think critically in a variety of disciplines. Learn how to program logic principles, identify security risks, select appropriate hardware and software computer components, and more.

### **BUSINESS &** ACCOUNTING

Develop a fundamental knowledge of the business functions and processes needed to succeed in today's global economy. Program includes concepts such as accounting, business law, economics, management, and marketing. Nearly all our business programs have certificate and diploma options, and can lead to an Associate in Applied Science, the recognized credential for community college technical program completion.

Craven's applied engineering programs such as Electronics and Mechatronics provide students with hands-on experience in the field. Graduates can support local construction, manufacturing, and the military. These programs have also recently undergone changes to allow students to learn sustainable technologies.

#### TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The transportation industry offers many fast-paced career opportunities. Our Associate in Automotive Systems Technology emphasizes a wellrounded curriculum that includes brakes, engine performance, automatic transmissions, diagnostics, and more, while our Associate in Aviation Systems Technology provides training in aircraft maintenance that prepares workers for employment at Fleet Readiness Center East at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point.
