NC STATE ENGINEERING


Through our exclusive partnership with NC State, students can earn a Bachelor's of Science in Engineering degree without ever leaving the Havelock campus. The program is housed in our new 16,000-square-foot STEM Center. We are proud to be the only community college in the state to offer this unique opportunity.

Students in this program are able to participate in enrichment opportunities such as design and robot competitions, community outreach design projects, plant tours, and technical seminars. After completing two years of pre-engineering courses at Craven CC, students can apply to transfer to one of NC State's 18 engineering Bachelor's degree programs, including the Mechanical Engineering Systems program based on our campus.

AVIATION

Students can help their careers take flight in our Institute of Aeronautical Technology, home to our esteemed aviation programs.

- Aviation Management and Career Pilot: This degree program includes a commercial pilot certificate with instrument rating, multiengine rating, and certified flight instructor rating. Students in this program have access to our state-of-the-art flight simulator and take to the sky with experienced instructors to ensure they are qualified for jobs as commercial, corporate, and military pilots.
- Aviation Systems Technology: Students become familiar with a wide variety of military and civilian aircraft from nose to tail. In this degree program, they can earn an FAA license and associate degree, which will transfer to Southern Illinois University's online program and allow students to complete a Bachelor's degree in Aviation Management without leaving the area.
- Aviation Sheet Metal: This certification program will educate students in several sheet metal fabrication skills. The program includes handson training with aircraft, sheet metal tool usage and safety, and proper installation. Students will have the opportunity to take the Career Readiness Certification exam and will develop an understanding of all duties assigned in an entry-level Aviation Sheet Metal position.



MILITARY FRIENDLY

Our convenient location and custom programs accommodate the transitory nature of military life. We strive to meet the diverse learning needs of MCAS Cherry Point, the Havelock community, and surrounding areas. We work closely with Fleet Readiness Center East, as well as employees stationed on base. Our Cherry Point location is a National Testing Center for CLEP, DANTES, and Pearson Vue.

We offer several programs designed specifically for our activeduty and veteran students, including Military Academic Skills and Tools for Advanced Manufacturing for Veterans. We also offer a number of resources and support, such as the Collegiate Veterans Association and Military Affairs Resource Center for students who are active duty, active duty dependents, veterans, or veteran dependents. Scholarships are available for all military, veterans, and dependents.

Additionally, students who are active duty, veterans, or dependents may qualify for one of our Military Benefit Programs. Several programs are eligible for VA benefits, and scholarships are available for qualifying veterans. The Military Affairs Resource Center assists all military-affiliated students in that process.


