
All students, employees and visitors who operate or park a vehicle on Craven Community College property are subject to the College's parking policy, procedures and regulations.

College traffic rules and regulations are intended to assure a steady flow of traffic; assure all streets and driveways are open and clear for emergency vehicles if needed; provide maximum safety to all persons on campus; provide an orderly system of traffic control; and promote the maximum utilization of parking areas. Traffic Rules & Regulations apply to all students, employees and visitors on the property of Craven Community College.

Parking Restrictions

The following areas contain "Restricted" or "No Parking" zones aboard the New Bern Campus:

 Lot #2 contains several areas reserved for VIPs, special guests, visitors, and security vehicles only




- Handicap Parking (must display a valid handicap placard or plate issued by the state)
- Yellow curbs/Cross walks
- Loading Zones/Alleyways

- Grass/Lawn
- Compound (Welding/Automotive area)
- Coned off areas
