COURSE AUDITS

The Board of Trustees authorizes the President to offer curriculum and non-curriculum courses for audit.

Auditing a course allows a student to take a class without receiving a grade, academic credit, continuing education unit, or certificate of completion. The president shall determine the curriculum and non-curriculum courses available for students to audit. Audited courses will not be considered in determining full-time or part-time enrollment status and will not satisfy enrollment requirements for graduation purposes.

Students may only enroll to audit a course during designated enrollment periods. Students may change from audit to credit status only during the course registration period. Students may change a course from credit to audit through the last day to withdraw.

Tuition and fees for audited courses are assessed at the same rate as that charged for enrolling in credit courses. Audited courses are not eligible for financial aid.

Students may audit courses on a space available basis and may not displace students taking a course for credit. Auditing students may not be counted in determining whether a course section meets minimum enrollment requirements. A class cannot be made up of solely auditing students.

Senior Citizens

Senior citizens (age 65 or older) may audit courses at Craven Community College free of registration and tuition fees. Fees other than registration or tuition must be paid by the senior citizen. Courses that may be audited tuition free by a senior citizen exclude the following:

- Lifetime Learning Program/Adult Enrichment Program,
- Self-Supporting programs,
- Business and Industry Training (Customized Training courses), or
- Ed2Go courses.

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
