




Basic Skills Student Progress: Index score based on the percentage of Basic Skills periods of participation (POPs) with a measureable skill gain (MSG) Period of Participation: A period of participation begins each time an ndividual enters adult education and receives at least 12 hours of service, even if there are multiple entries during the same program year. If an ndividual has a gap in service of more than 90 days, and returns during the same program year, a new period of participation is established.
