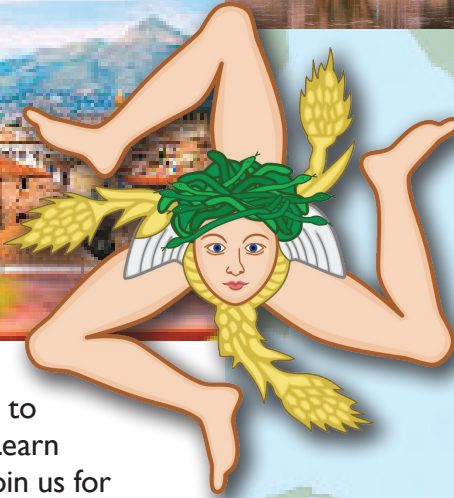


# An International Travel and Learn Adventure

We will uncover Sicily's capital Palermo with its Moorish and Norman influences, explore seaside Cefalù and Agrigento's ancient Valley of the Temples, travel to the historic hilltop town of Taormina, and visit a local winery for a wine tasting and gourmet dinner. The adventure continues as we explore the ancient cave dwellings of Sassi di Matera, as well as the coastal cities of Sorrento and Positano on the Amalfi Coast. Walk in the footsteps of the ancient Romans in the excavated Pompeii.

# Day by Day Itinerary

## Day 1: Sun, May 25 - Overnight Flight

The hidden treasures of Southern Italy and Sicily are yours to explore, for it's here you'll find breathtaking scenery, historic cities, centuries-old hilltop villages and iconic cuisine.

## Day 2: Mon., May 26 - Palermo, Sicily - Tour Begins

Your Italian sojourn opens in Palermo, the capital of Sicily. Discover the city's vibrant culture as you take in its gritty, unshakable spirit and captivating energy. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner featuring authentic Sicilian cuisine. (D)

## Day 3: Tues., May 27 - Palermo - Monreale

Begin the day with a walking tour of Palermo's old town. Uncover cobblestoned piazzas and ornate buildings, many worn by time and conflict. Visit hilltop Monreale (UNESCO), ascending on foot to its 12th-century cathedral for a guided tour of its majestic Byzantine mosaics. Explore the cathedral's cloisters, taking in their serene atmosphere of the monastic complex before returning to Palermo for an evening at leisure. (B)

## Day 4: Wed., May 28 - Cefalù - Agrigento

This morning, set off for the stunning seaside town of Cefalù on Sicily's northern coast. Stroll the charming medieval streets with a local guide and visit the city's impressive cathedral showcasing Norman architecture. Next, journey to a family-owned farmhouse, picturesquely set in the surrounding hills. Meet the owners and discover what a typical day on a Sicilian farm is like. Sit back and tuck into a hearty farm-to-table lunch, made with family recipes. Relax aboard your bus as you travel over rolling hills and peaceful farmland to Sicily's southern coast for a relaxing 2-night stay. (B, L, D)

## Day 5: Thurs., May 29 - Valley of the Temples

Step back 25 centuries and delve into ancient Greek history for a visit of the stunning Valley of the Temples (UNESCO), one of the world's most esteemed archeological sites. Get an up-close view of the temples of Juno, Concordia, and Hercules during an extensive walking tour of this vast archeological site. The afternoon is yours to relax. This evening, pause for dinner at a local restaurant and an evening view of the illuminated Valley of the Temples. (B, D)

## Day 6: Fri., May 30 - Piazza Armerina - Giardini Naxos

Venture deep into Sicily's countryside to Piazza Armerina, home of the ancient Villa Romana del Casale (UNESCO) and explore the site with an expert insider for a locally guided tour of its impressive mosaics. In the afternoon, journey east to Sicily's Ionian Coast and to Giardini Naxos – the “garden of Sicily” – for your 2-night stay. (B, D)

## Day 7: Sat. May 31 - Giardini Naxos - Taormina

This morning, explore beautiful Taormina, home to ancient relics, rocky hills, and charming gardens. With an expert local guide, you'll stroll the lively pedestrianized main street, see the imposing Corvaja Palace and climb to the city's well-preserved Greek theatre. The afternoon is yours to explore more of this hillside resort or see Sicily's wilder side on an optional off-road adventure to Mount Etna (UNESCO). During this optional tour, stare up at the iconic peak as your vehicle climbs along the sides of Europe's largest active volcano. This evening let traditional Sicilian melodies fill the air during an optional Sicilian dinner with musical accompaniment. (B)

## Day 8: Sun., June 1 - Giardini Naxos - Matera

Take a short ferry ride to Villa San Giovanni, located on Italy's mainland. During your full day bus transfer, pass through the unspoiled region of Calabria to the Basilicata region. Wander through the twisting vines of a local winery before touring the cellar for a tasting. Linger over regional cuisine at dinner in the winery's *agriturismo* restaurant. (B, D)

## Day 9: Mon., June 2 - Matera

Explore the Sassi di Matera (UNESCO), an ancient settlement of carved cave dwellings. A local guide shares the history and explains why film producers are seeking out this unique landscape. Visit a local shop and to get a taste of regional specialties. The afternoon is at your leisure. Optional tour to Alberobello (UNESCO) in the nearby region of Puglia. (B, D)

## Day 10: Tues., June 3, 2025 Matera - Sorrento

After a stop at a sustainable buffalo dairy farm for a taste of freshly made mozzarella and a peek into the history of this iconic cheese, arrive in Sorrento where you'll settle in for a 2-night stay. Later this afternoon, discover this charming seaside town during a walking tour and learn about the local tradition of wood marquetry. (B, L)



## Day 11: Wed., June 4 - Sorrento - Positano

This morning, take in the sights and colors of the Mediterranean Sea as you sail along the initial stretch of the breathtaking Amalfi Coast (UNESCO). Gaze out over the deep blue hues of the sea paired with the bright citrus fruits lining the hillsides. Pause in Positano with its pastel-colored houses and pebbly beaches. Spend time in this legendary locale browsing the posh boutiques or resting along the beach, before returning to Sorrento for an afternoon at leisure. (B)

## Day 12: Thurs., June 5 - Sorrento - Pompeii - Rome

Journey north to Rome. En route, experience the excavated ruins of Pompeii (UNESCO). A local guide gives you an in-depth look into this 2,000-year-old Roman town, nestled in the foothills of Mount Vesuvius. Step into another time as you explore its preserved buildings and imagine life in the 1st century. An afternoon-long transfer leads to Rome where you arrive in the early evening. Celebrate your arrival in Rome with a dinner in a local restaurant. (B, D)

## Day 13: Fri., June 6 - Rome

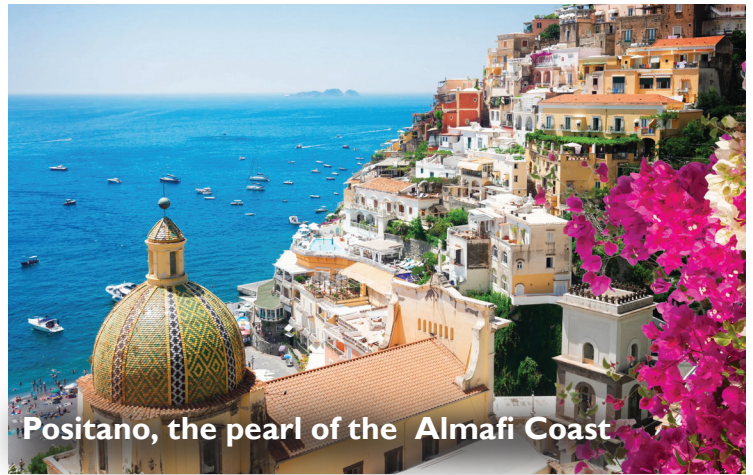
Enjoy a guided walking tour of Classical Rome, leading you through the Eternal City's most iconic monuments. Walk over cobblestone streets and weathered passageways to discover famous sights such as the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and Piazza Navona, one of Rome's most breathtaking Baroque piazzas. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. Perhaps you'll wander through one of Rome's many museums, such as the Capitoline or stroll the Avenue of the Imperial Forum for views of the Colosseum. (B)

## Day 14: Sat., June 7, Rome - Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica

Take advantage of seeing more on your own. Early this morning join an expert local guide for a visit of the Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica, including the world-famous Sistine Chapel where Michelangelo's *Last Judgement* and ceiling frescos are located. The afternoon is yours. Perhaps you'll explore Rome's bohemian *Trastevere* district and wander through its maze-like, ivy-clung streets. (B)

## Day 15: Sun., June 8 - Rome - Tour Ends

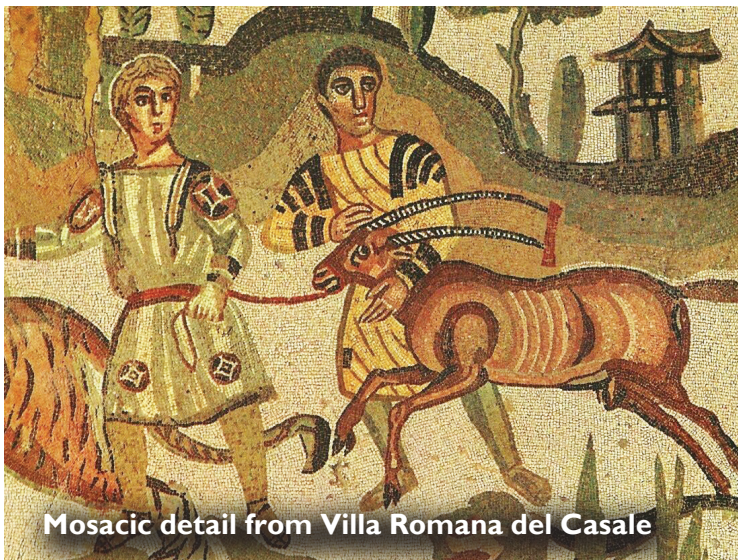

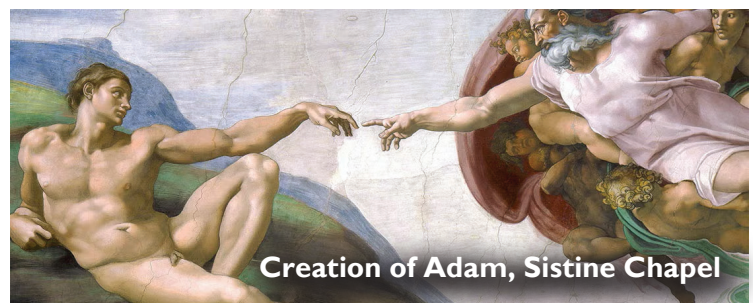
## This Tour is rated Activity Level 3

(on a scale of 1 to 4)

You're an on-the-go traveler. For this tour, participants should be able to walk and stand for longer periods of time (2-3 hours). Moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tours, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, are a part of the itinerary. You should be able to climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Participants may opt out of any particular activity during the tour, but note that this may mean that they miss some items listed on the itinerary.

# Pricing and Terms

The cost per person for this tour is based on a double occupancy rate. We can provide single occupancy accommodations at an additional cost of \$1,350 per person. **The number of single rooms is limited** and will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. For that reason, you may want to consider a roommate for this trip. *If you are interested in finding an appropriate roommate to take advantage of the double occupancy rates, we will be pleased to share contact information with others seeking a roommate. Please let us know of your interest.*

We have planned a truly comprehensive experience, including a hometown transfer to RDU, round-trip airfare, assistance through security and customs, all transfers, accommodations for 13 nights, 22 meals, professional guide and driver, admissions and views as described in the itinerary and ground transportation for all excursions.

Jennifer Baer, Director of The Lifetime Learning Center, will escort the group and work in partnership with CLB Travel and our professional guide for the benefit, comfort, and safety of the group from departure to return. In addition, Jennifer will be offering suggestions and providing additional resources to help you take advantage of your free time.
