

Associate Degree Nursing (A45110) & Diploma in Practical Nursing (D45660)

The Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) and the Diploma in Practical Nursing curricula, approved by the North Carolina Board of Nursing and offered only in seated format, prepares individuals with the knowledge and skills necessary to become a registered nurse. Course content relates to the nurse's role as a provider and manager of care, as a member of the discipline of nursing, and as a part of the interdisciplinary team. Graduates of Craven's ADN program are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN), which is required to practice as a registered nurse in all 50 states. Once a student has passed the NCLEX-RN and has obtained a license to practice nursing in the State of North Carolina, they can seek licensure through reciprocity in another state that is a member of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC). The NLC provides the opportunity for NC-licensed RNs to practice in North Carolina and all other NLC states.

Craven also offers the Diploma in Practical Nursing (PN). That program's curriculum prepares students with the knowledge and skill to provide nursing care to children and adults. Students will participate in assessment, planning, implementing, and evaluating nursing care. Graduates are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-PN), which is required for practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

Craven's Nursing program is fully accredited by the National League for Nursing, Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation (NLN CNEA).

Why are students receiving this disclosure?

On November 1, 2019, the U.S Department of Education published Final Regulations for accreditation and state authorization. The regulations address the role of reciprocity agreements, update the language regarding student location, clarify required state authorizations for distance education programs, and revise consumer disclosure requirements that become effective July 1, 2020. These final regulations, among other things:

- Make clear that an institution must identify the State in which a student is "located" and, therefore, the State in which the institution must have authorization;
- Expand consumer protections for students enrolled in programs that lead to occupational licensure, including those enrolled in seated courses or programs;
- Enable institutions to determine the States for which it will determine occupational licensing requirements, while requiring institutions to report that information accurately to students

To be following the regulation's disclosure requirements and consumer protections, Craven has researching licensure requirements for Registered Nurses (RNs) and Practical Nurses (LPNs) in those states that are no currently members of the NLC.

See also the NCSBN's 2023 Uniform Licensure Requirements (ULRs) that specify the essential prerequisites for initial, endorsement, renewal, and reinstatement licensure across every NCSBN jurisdiction to ensure the safe and competent practice of nursing. In addition to protecting the public by setting consistent standards and promoting a health care system that is fluid and accessible by removing barriers to care and maximizing portability for nursing, the ULRs assure the consumer that a nurse in one state has met the requirements of

Do you plan to leave North Carolina?

The U.S. Department of Education's 2019 regulations require that all institutions of higher learning track the location of its students – not necessarily their permanent addresses or their state of residence. If you are considering relocating to another state before gaining licensure in North Carolina, we urge you to contact your advisor or the Dean of Health Sciences to confirm licensure requirements in your destination state.

If you are considering relocating to an NLC member state after gaining licensure in North Carolina, you are responsible for applying for licensure by endorsement in the new state of residence. This should be completed upon moving and should not be delayed as there is no grace period. Moreover, you should not wait until your North Carolina license expires to apply in your new state of legal residency. You may practice on your North Carolina state license only UNTIL the multi-state license in the new NLC home state is issued. Proof of residency, such as a driver's license, may be required. Upon issuance of a new multi-state license, your North Carolina license will be deactivated.

If you relocate to an NLC member state after completion of your associate degree or diploma but before taking and passing the appropriate NCLEX, you can obtain licensure by examination in any NLC member state. That multi-state license will allow you to practice in any NLC member state. To apply for a multi-state nursing license, you must:

- Be a resident in an NLC state and you must declare an NLC state as your primary state of residency
- Be actively licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical/Professional/Vocational Nurse (LPN/LVN)
- Continue to meet any requirements for licensure in your home state BUT when practicing, you will also be held to the standards of the state where the patient or practice is located

There currently are 38 states that have enacted NLC legislation and are members of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing's Nursing Licensure Compact (NLC). These include:

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If you relocate to a non-NLC member state after gaining North Carolina licensure, your multi-state license is changed to a single-state license upon changing legal residency. You are responsible for notifying the Board of Nursing (BON) of the former NLC state of the new address and you must meet the licensure-by-endorsement/examination requirements of the non-NLC member state.

Be sure to review the nursing licensure requirements in those states that have NOT yet adopted or implemented NLC legislation. For specific licensure requirements in the state listed above, please contact your advisor or the Dean of Health Sciences.

Although Craven's ADN and PN programs are only offered in seated format, you can determine the host state/territory requirements for Distance Education pre-licensure nursing programs [here](#). Please note that only BON requirements are listed and no other state/territory requirements, such as those from the Boards of Higher Education, Departments of Health, and/or other regulating/licensing agencies.
