Given the nursing program's limited capacity, candidates with the highest points will be offered a seat, and remaining qualified applicants will be positioned on a waitlist. Should vacancies become available before the LPN-ADN Program begins, students on the waitlist will receive an offer of a seat in the nursing program. The waitlist remains operational solely for the current cohort, all students are removed once the semester begins. Applicants who are not selected can reapply during the upcoming application period.
