Each applicant's accumulated bonus points are added to their TEAS total score, resulting in a comprehensive point total. Eligible candidates will be organized based on their total achieved points. Given the nursing program's limited capacity, candidates with the highest points will be offered a seat, and remaining qualified applicants will be positioned on a waitlist. Should vacancies become available before the commencement of the ADN Program, the subsequent students on the waitlist will receive an offer of a seat in the nursing program. The waitlist remains operational solely for the current cohort, with all students being removed once the semester initiates. Applicants that are not selected have the option to reapply during the upcoming application period.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring the Health Programs Admissions and Advising Coordinator has received all required documentation.

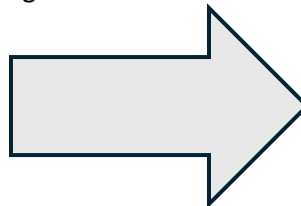
