As a high school student in Craven County, you are eligible to take college classes that are 100% tuition free! Your only costs are books and/or software. Eligible students are able to apply college credits from Craven Community College's (Craven CC) Career & College Promise (CCP) Program and use them to accelerate the completion of a college certificate, diploma, or associate degree after graduating from high school.





GET STARTED IN 6 EASY STEPS

Step 1: Review pathway information located at cravencc.edu/CCP

Step 2: Apply to Craven Community College

Step 3: Complete CCP enrollment form

Step 4: Contact CCP Advisor

Step 5: Prepare documents for advising session

Step 6: Attend mandatory CCP student orientation

- CCP advising appointments may be scheduled online
- Craven CC application may be completed online

CAREER-TECHNICAL PATHWAY

If you are a high school junior or senior in a career cluster program at your local school, this pathway will give you the opportunity to enroll in a Craven CC certificate program that aligns with your high school program. Available certificates include but are not limited to:

 - Health Information Technology

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COLLEGE TRANSFER PATHWAY

If you are a high school junior or senior planning to attend a community college transfer program or a four-year college, this pathway will allow you to complete some of the core general education classes required during the first two years of a four-year degree.

- Associate in Arts (AA)
- Associate in Engineering (AE)
- Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) - Music
- Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) - Visual Arts
- Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)
- Associate in Science (AS)
- Associate in Arts - Teacher Prep (AATP)
- Associate in Science - Teacher Prep (ASTP)

Students who meet established guidelines can transfer their credits to one of the 16 public institutions in the UNC System and to many of the independent colleges within North Carolina. Students who complete the AATP, ASTP, AE, AFA-Music, or AFA-Visual Arts are qualified to transfer to a university program in these fields.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

The following forms are required for your advising appointment:

- CCP application with all required signatures
- Official high school transcript
- Copy of Pre-ACT, PSAT, SAT, ACT (if GPA is below 2.8)

Students with an unweighted grade point average (GPA) of 2.8 or higher automatically qualify for the CCP program. If a student does not hold a GPA of 2.8, they may be considered through other eligibility benchmarks that demonstrate college readiness. Students also have the option to complete the Career & College Ready Pathway to meet the eligibility benchmarks.

New students must attend a mandatory orientation session. During orientation, you will:

- Discover campus resources and opportunities
- Understand academic expectations and what it takes to be a successful student
- Learn to navigate and set up your student email, Moodle, and Self-Service accounts
