NC STATE ENGINEERING

Through our exclusive partnership with NC State, students can earn an ABET-accredited Bachelor of Science in Engineering degree with a concentration in Mechanical Engineering Systems or Electrical Engineering Systems without ever leaving the Havelock campus. The program is housed in our 16,000-square-foot STEM Center. We are proud to be the only community college in the state to offer this unique opportunity. Students complete general education and pre-engineering courses at Craven CC and then apply for transfer to the NC State Havelock Engineering Program located on our campus. Students participate in design projects each semester and interact with professional engineers in the classroom, with opportunities to gain valuable work experience through paid local internships.

Graduates of our aviation AAS degrees have the option to transfer to either Southern Illinois University's online Bachelor of Aviation Management degree program or East Carolina University's Bachelor of Science in Industrial Technology degree program.

Aviation Management Technology

This program provides a launching pad for students interested in pursuing a degree in the field of aviation. Students get access to our state-of-the-art flight simulator and experience a full range of aviation-related courses to ensure they are qualified for a variety of positions in a growing and exciting market.

Aviation Systems Technology

This program prepares students for careers as aviation maintenance technicians. Students apply theoretical knowledge to real-world scenarios using state-of-the-art training simulators, aircraft engines, and a wide variety of military and civilian aircraft. Students who complete the program receive an associate degree and graduate ready to sit for the FAA Airframe and Powerplant certification exams.

CHERRY POINT OFFICE

Craven CC's advising office aboard Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point addresses the unique academic, financial, and social needs of our military personnel, military dependents, veterans, and civilians. Our advisors provide one-on-one assistance, enabling you to get the most out of college while easing the challenges of balancing a military career and education. In addition to classes offered on the Havelock and New Bern campuses and online, we offer evening classes conducted at the Jerry Marvel Training & Education Building on base. Our Cherry Point office, in partnership with the Marine Corps Community Services Education Program, operates a National Testing Center (NTC) aboard MCAS Cherry Point. The NTC offers CLEP, DANTES (DSST), and Pearson VUE testing.


