Craven CC Health Information Technology Admissions Worksheet

Applications may be submitted at any time during the year. Admission to the program occurs once annually, with a new cohort beginning each Fall semester. All required documents must be received by June 30 to be considered for admission. After the deadline, qualified candidates are ranked based on total points earned. Program seats are offered in order from highest to lowest point totals. Those who are not initially selected are placed on a waitlist for that admission cycle. If a seat becomes available before the Fall semester begins, the next person on the waitlist will be offered admission. The waitlist applies only to that specific cycle. Individuals who are not selected must submit a new application during the next cycle to be considered again.

*Applicants are responsible for ensuring the Admissions Office has received **all** required documentation.*

❖ Minimum Application Requirements – Required by June 30th

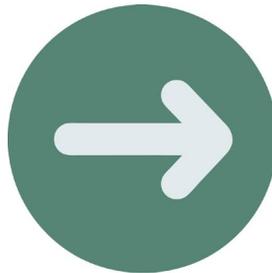
Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, calculated as follows:

- *Craven Community College GPA (if ≥ 12 credit hours completed), **or***
- *Cumulative GPA of all college coursework (if < 12 credit hours completed at Craven), **or***
- High school unweighted GPA (if no college coursework has been completed)

Prior to the application deadline, applicants must meet the developmental requirements for the general education courses in the plan of the study.

High school or GED transcripts must be on file at Craven Community College
