Once an applicant has met the minimum application requirements, the applicant will be ranked based on points earned and will be admitted in order of highest total score. The PTA Program can accept up to 22 students per class and remaining applicants who qualify for admission will be maintained on an alternate list and will be admitted in order of ranking if a PTA student slot opens prior to the beginning of fall semester. If a qualified applicant is not selected, the applicant must reapply to enter the next fall cohort.

Applications will be open all year. Observation hours and TEAS testing must be completed from February 1st through May 31st. Applicants are responsible for assuring that all transcripts, observation forms, and supporting documents for admission points are submitted by May 31st.

- Prior to the application deadline, applicants must meet the developmental requirements for the general education courses in the plan of the study.
- High school or GED transcripts must be on file at Craven Community College
- Observation hours with subsequent reflection (see Observation Verification form for details)
- Chemistry in high school or college (CHM 090 or higher) with a grade of “C” or higher

The letter of verification on company letterhead from the employer must include (1) dates of employment, (2) number of hours worked, (3) job title, (4) brief job description, (5) signature and professional title of the applicant’s supervisor, (6) supervisor’s work phone and email.
