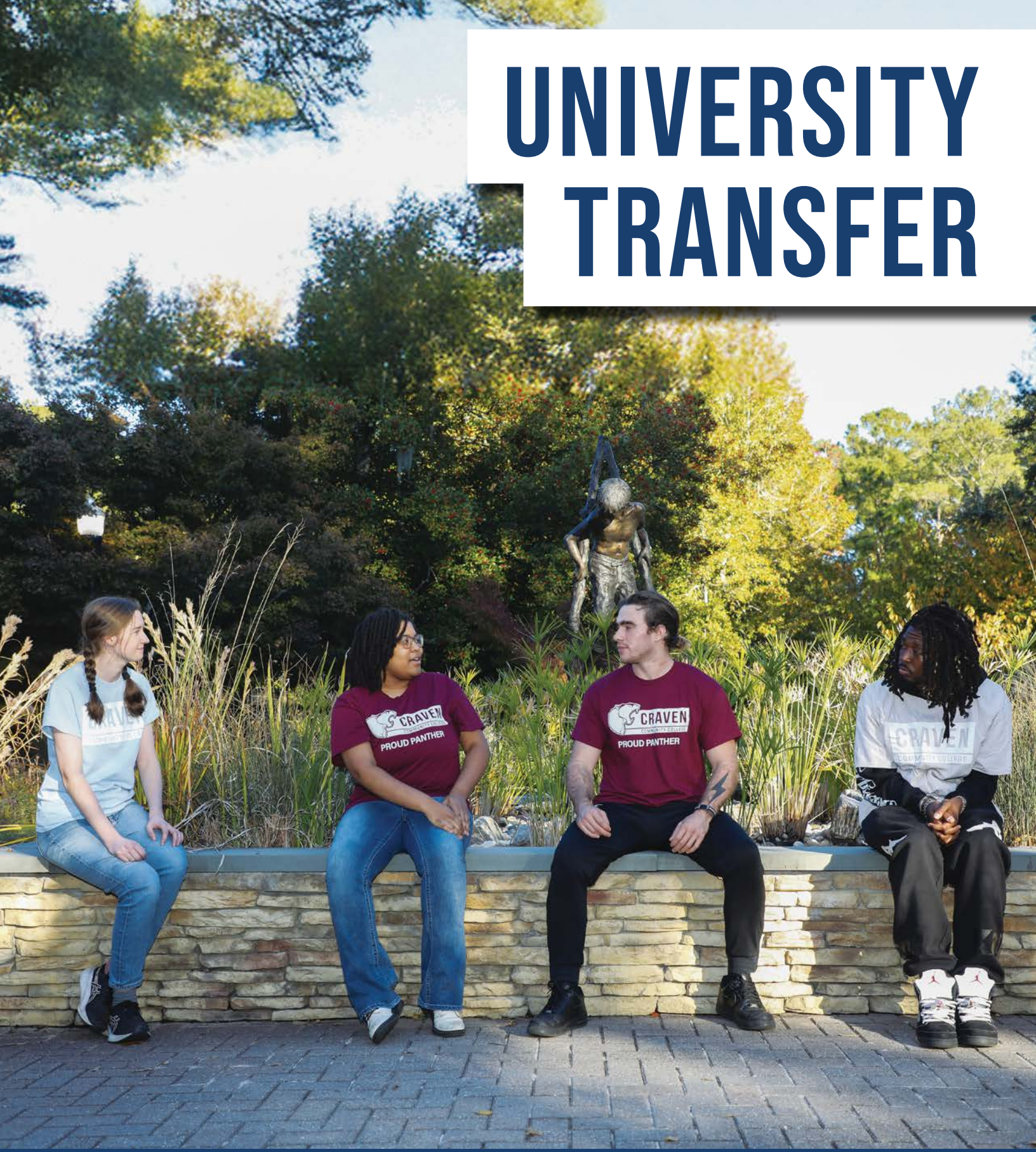

ASSOCIATE IN ARTS

The Associate in Arts (AA) program is designed for students who plan to transfer to a college or university and complete a bachelor of arts degree. This degree leads students to develop a strong foundation in English, fine arts, humanities, social/behavioral sciences, mathematics, and natural sciences. The coursework within the AA meets most freshman and sophomore requirements at the baccalaureate level.

ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE

The Associate in Science (AS) program is designed for students who plan to transfer to a college or university and complete a bachelor of science degree. The AS degree emphasizes natural sciences and mathematics and also provides students with a solid foundation in English, fine arts, humanities, and social/behavioral sciences. Students also take enough elective hours to allow further exploration in areas of interest. The coursework within the AS meets most freshman and sophomore requirements at the baccalaureate level.

ASSOCIATE IN ENGINEERING

The Associate in Engineering (AE) program is designed to prepare students to transfer into one of the five Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) accredited engineering programs in North Carolina. Coursework includes upper-level mathematics and general education credits, as well as an Intro to Engineering course (EGR 150) that helps students understand the multiple specialties within engineering. Students who complete the AE will be well qualified to apply to any of the engineering programs in North Carolina.

ASSOCIATE IN FINE ARTS

Craven CC offers two fine arts degrees: Associate in Fine Arts in Visual Arts (AFA-Visual) and Associate in Fine Arts in Music (AFA-Music). These programs are designed for students intending to transfer to a four-year university to complete a bachelor of arts degree, a bachelor of fine arts degree, or a bachelor of music degree. Twenty-eight semester hours are dedicated to a general education core, while 36 hours remain for students to take a deep dive into their study of music or art. The AFA program is also perfect for those wanting a comprehensive study of music or art without pursuing a bachelor's degree.

TEACHER PREPARATION

The Associate in Arts in Teacher Preparation (AATP) and Associate in Science in Teacher Preparation (ASTP) programs are designed to prepare students to transfer to a four-year university to obtain a bachelor of education degree. Specialized coursework covers multiple grade levels and subjects, ranging from kindergarten through grade 12, as well as hands-on student teaching experience, which is required for licensing in most states.

TRANSFERABILITY

Craven CC has extensive transfer agreements with all North Carolina public institutions, as well as many private ones, ensuring students can seamlessly transfer credits to pursue a bachelor's or specialized degree in North Carolina and beyond.

- The Carolina Student Transfer Excellence Program (C-STEP) supports high-achieving students in completing an AA or AS at Craven, then transferring to UNC Chapel Hill.
- East Carolina University's SECU Partnership East allows students to complete an elementary or middle grades teaching degree onsite at Craven CC's New Bern campus.
- NC State University's Havelock Engineering Program allows students to complete a bachelor of science in engineering with a concentration in Mechanical Engineering Systems or Electrical Engineering Systems onsite at Craven CC's Havelock campus.
- NC State's Wolfpack Connect partnership allows Craven CC students who complete eligible AA or AS degrees to transfer directly to NC State.
- Fayetteville State University's (FSU) Bronco Benefit initiative allows Craven CC graduates who complete specified degree programs to transfer to FSU.
- UNC Wilmington's Secondary Teacher Education Partnership Initiative (STEP-IN) program allows Craven CC students earning an AA or AS to transfer into UNCW's online teacher preparation program.

GLOBAL & CULTURAL INITIATIVES

Craven CC recognizes the importance of global connections and honors them with outreach programs across the state and the world. Our Study Abroad initiative allows students to study in other parts of the world and foster a richer global perspective. Recent Study Abroad destinations include Italy, Croatia, Ireland, Scotland, Spain, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Peru, and Bosnia and Herzegovina. Craven also offers the Scholar of Global Distinction Program, combining globally intensive courses, international activities, and experiences to deepen students' global learning.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Craven CC's high standards in the classroom and dedicated faculty ensure a university-quality education for your first and second years of college. Extracurricular opportunities—such as the renowned chapter of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society and the college's Honors Program—guarantee students strong interdisciplinary connections. Eligibility for these organizations and programs is available to students who complete 12 curriculum hours and earn a 3.5 GPA or higher.

EMBRACING THE ARTS

At Craven CC, we value and nurture the talents of emerging musicians and artists. Encore!, the college's chamber choir, performs throughout the community alongside new opportunities through Craven Concert Band and Craven Chorus. Studio art students often participate in the college's annual art show, and the winning piece is awarded the President's Art Award and becomes part of the college's permanent art collection. The collection is housed across the New Bern campus, with each piece labeled with the artist's name and the title of the work.

WANT TO GET INVOLVED?

Students who maintain a 3.5 (B+) GPA are eligible for membership in the college's chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, the international two-year honor society.

Some students also join the Student Government Association or Hurst Student Ambassadors program, both of which provide scholarships to qualified students in exchange for their service.

STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL?

Through the Career & College Promise (CCP) program, high school students can earn eligible credits toward an associate degree. Students should contact their local high school counselors or Craven's CCP Advisor to learn more.
